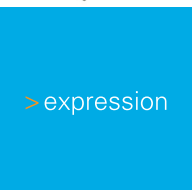

“All kinds of navigational charts have inspired me – from very early Polynesian charts to modern subway maps.”

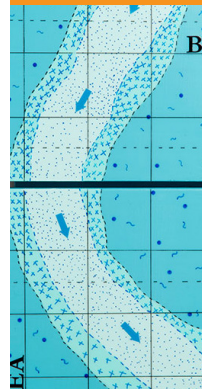
