Eleanor Rahim's abstract and figurative art is the result of classical study combined with fast gestural movement that channel and stimulate the subconscious. The human figure, with its proportional and balanced structure, is the inspiration and foundation of Rahim's work. She is wondrous of the human spirit within the mechanism of the human body. Rahim mentally absorbs snapshots of life, color, texture, decay, motion, sound, joy, sadness and renewal.

"The challenge and excitement for me is to capture the energy, sensuality, spirit and movement of the form as my passions dictate."

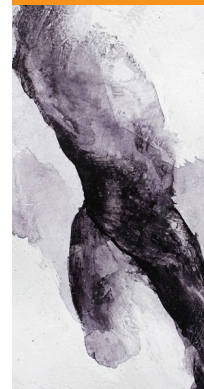
