# Ken Steinkamp

## An Artist's Journey

My life as an artist began when I was very young growing up in a small farming town in Iowa. The landscape was flat with soft rolling hills and black soil. The horizon was always visible, and as I traveled about, I was captivated by its light and the mysteries that were beyond it.


I began taking art classes in junior high. Images of telephone poles, wires along solitary two lane roads with brilliant sky colors – filtered by tree limbs in winter's light – began to show up in my paintings. During that time, I was also drawn to Jackson Pollock's emotive abstract style. Encouraged by my teachers I began to develop my own expressive style. I entered college on a four-year scholarship to become an art teacher.

During this time, younger instructors with their freer teaching approach and the changing of social mores of the 60's, encouraged my personal style of lines, layers, texture, figures and conceptual art.

After graduation, I enlisted in the Army and by chance qualified to work in the White House Photo Lab, in Washington, DC. Graduate school followed, paid by the GI Bill at the University of Wisconsin – Madison, followed by teaching for two years in Madison.

Soon after, travel beckoned and I began a career as a flight attendant with American Airlines based in Los Angeles. For the twenty-eight years that followed, I was able to explore a variety of destinations in the US and Europe, and the cultural opportunities they presented. During my considerable time off, I would create in my studio and commensurate with other artists.

I subsequently moved to New England and retired in 2007 where I have continued to grow my extensive body of abstract work in my studio by in part referencing those countless journeys into horizons I have taken and the lines, layers and art they inspired.





### "Reflection"

Reflection is the title of Ken Steinkamp's most recent body of work. Completed in the past year, these medium to large paintings again explore his signature theme of life's enigma by vigorously exploring surfaces on wood and acrylic panels. Surfaces that are further enriched by piercing, subtle, impulsive lines, shapes and color.

For this exhibition, Steinkamp has added a variety of metal panels to provide a reflective edge and, in turn, inviting each viewer to reflect on their own world of shadows, dreams and enigma.
